## In focus: Industry and fire protection

In June SPECK Pumpen were represented at the Interschutz in Hannover and the Achema in Frankfurt/Main and were the leaders in the safety separation system sector. SPECK Pumpen score big with industrial applications above all through the variety of the products and their flexibility.

With around 160,000 visitors each, both trade fairs were very well attended. While the discussions in Hannover focussed more overtly on booster units for wall hydrant supply, in Frankfurt it was all about the endless application possibilities of pumps in the chemical, pharmaceutical and food industry.

**Interschutz, Hannover** - There for the first time as an exhibitor, SPECK Pumpen was able to welcome many fire prevention specialists, plumbers and property managers to the trade fair stand. Around 50 % of whom were new customers. Discussions with existing customers provided valuable impulses for future product developments.

With the units from the Feuercell II and Multicell II ranges SPECK Pumpen has a strong position within fire extinguishing technology. When installed subsequently in exisiting old buildings, these units can be particularly well adjusted to the circumstances on site. Of course the units use state of the art technology: the reliable separation of drinking water and fire extinguishing water is an essential quality criterion and is carried out according to DIN 14462.

Dieter Schäfczuk, sales assistant for domestic technology, is already looking forward to the next Interschutz. "We gave it a try and we were successful. As an exhibitor you learn a lot of inside infomation about the industry that you would otherwise miss out on."

Achema, Frankfurt - "For pump manufacturers in the industrial sector the Achema is simply a must," according to the head of sales for domestic and insutrial technology, Andreas Politaj. Along with his trade fair team he welcomed many good acquaintances in Frankfurt with new contacts coming mainly from overseas. A consistently positive mood was perceived throughout the industrial sector.

Thermal oil pumps from the TOE range for flow temperatures of up to 400 °C were very much in demand. SPECK Pumpen offer additional monitoring systems which inform the user of vibrations, temperatures, leakages and the condition of the unit and pump. Other trade fair highlights were high pressure pumps for CO2 delivery, vertical, staged centrifugal pumps and vacuum pumps.
